**Laird A. Lile appointed to Florida Courts Technology Commission  
by Florida Supreme Court**

NAPLES, Fla. (Oct. 11, 2010) – Laird A. Lile, a wills, trusts and estates attorney in Naples, has been appointed to a three-year term on the Florida Courts Technology Commission by the Florida Supreme Court.

The commission was established as a permanent judicial branch commission to oversee, manage and direct the development and use of technology within the judicial branch under the direction of the Florida Supreme Court.

Lile is one of 25 appointees to the commission, whose members include circuit, county and appellate court judges; court administrators and technology officers; clerks of court for several Florida counties and judicial districts; and two other practicing attorneys. Justice Barbara J. Pariente serves as the Florida Supreme Court liaison to the commission.

Lile, who was recently inducted into Florida Trend's 2010 Legal Elite Hall of Fame, has been certified by The Florida Bar as a Wills, Trusts and Estates lawyer since 1989. Lile is a member of the Board of Governors for The Florida Bar and past chair of its Real Property, Probate & Trust Law Section. He has been included in Woodward/White's "The Best Lawyers in America" since 1995 and is recognized as one of Florida's "100 Top Super Lawyers."

A graduate of the College of William and Mary, Ohio Northern University and University of Miami, Lile resides in Naples with his wife and two children.
